As we show that we are willing to have complete faith in Jesus Christ, He will be with us through every step, no matter how tough our life may seem.

The Savior has promised that “I will go before your face. I will be on your right hand and on your left, and my Spirit shall be in your hearts, and mine angels round about you, to bear you up.” (D&C 84:88) Through faith in Jesus Christ we will be able face all challenges that are around us. He will lift us up and get us through any trial we are facing now, and will get us through any trial we will face in the future.

As President Russell M. Nelson has taught, “True disciples of Jesus Christ are willing to stand out, speak up, and be different from the people of the world. There is nothing easy or automatic about becoming such powerful disciples. Our focus must be riveted on the Savior and His gospel. It is mentally rigorous to strive to look unto Him in every thought. But when we do, our doubts and fears flee.”

May we always be striving to increase our faith in Jesus Christ. Jesus Christ wants us to be happy. He loves us. He knows each one of us individually. Turn to Him and put your faith in Him that He may be with you at all times and in all places.
