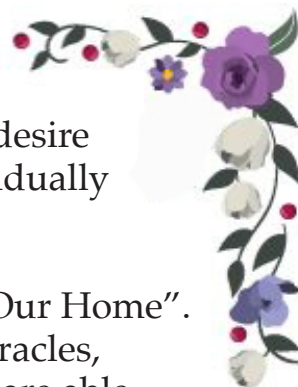
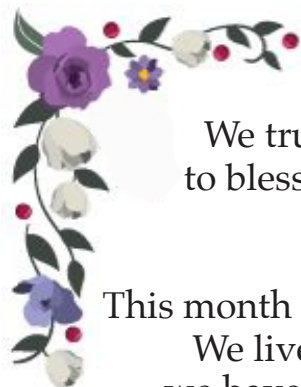

importantly we have the knowledge of our savior Jesus Christ and his atonement.

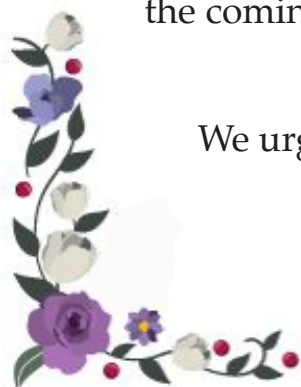
Satan is working harder than ever to remove us and to confuse us

Monologue or Dialogue?

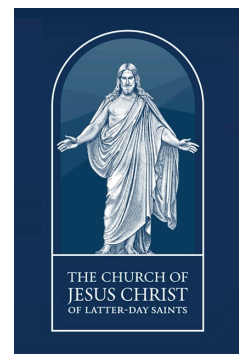
When we pray, do we do all the speaking or do we speak, then listen, and then respond to what we heard?

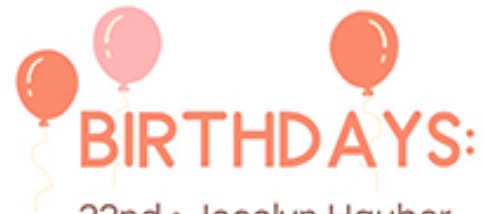
