In the April 2017 general conference elder Hales said “Many people hear the word disciple and think it means only “follower.” But genuine discipleship is a state of being. This suggests more than studying and applying a list of individual attributes. Disciples live so that the characteristics of Christ are woven into the fiber of their beings, as into a spiritual tapestry.’



One of the hallmarks of a true disciple of Jesus Christ is how we interact with others — especially when we find ourselves in deep disagreement.

The way we treat our fellow men, even through the fog of intensely negative emotions, is a test of our dedication to following the Master.

The Savior commanded the Twelve Apostles to love one another as He loved them. He then taught them this principle, “By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.” John 13:35. We must behave toward others as though we love them in the same way that the Savior loves them.

President Nelson has said, ‘The Savior’s message is clear: His true disciples build, lift, encourage, persuade, and inspire — no matter how difficult the situation. True disciples of Jesus Christ are peacemakers.’ Whatever the situation may be, we have the power to decide to react in the way the Savior would want us to, in a way that demonstrates that we are true followers of Jesus Christ. Marcus Aurelius said, ‘If you are distressed by anything external, the pain is not due to the thing itself, but to your estimate of it; and this you have the power to revoke at any moment.’

We echo the invitation of President Nelson when he said, ‘Today I invite you to examine your discipleship within the context of the way you treat others. I bless you to make any adjustments that may be needed so that your behavior is ennobling, respectful, and representative of a true follower of Jesus Christ.’
